What is your family history at sea?

Our cousin spent a lot of time researching our family history at sea and discovered that it dates back to the 1800s. The first in this line (that we know of), started sailing at the fall of the Venetian Empire, transporting wine and olive oil between the mainland and island Brac. The boats and industry were a little different then, but every generation has had its challenges, and we wouldn't be here without all those that came before us. My brother and I are the eighth generation working at sea, and this is something we are immensely proud of.
